The mission of MAYA includes:

- Developing a Montessori-based methodology tailored for young women's professional and personal growth.
- Creating a supportive learning environment through Open Educational Resources, mentoring programs, and interactive tools.
- Increasing employability and social inclusion by equipping young women with the skills they need to thrive in the job market.

The project **key outcomes** include:

- A comprehensive Montessori-based curriculum for youth workers.
- A mentoring program designed for young adult inactive NEET women.
- Case studies, practice collections, and literacy reviews.
- A set of KPIs and competences to measure progress.
- An interactive online platform with open education resources and multimedia.
